#### DOG DAYS OF SUMMER!

As we roll into Summertime, we are so thankful that events are returning, slowly but surely. We suffered through last year, losing a lot of fundraisers, which put us behind monetarily. We thank you all for helping us to maintain through donations of money and items, and for supporting our online fundraising when it was possible.

But now that WV is opening back up we can get back to a new normal. We are planning on cramming what activities we can in this year, and then hopefully 2022 will get us back to spacing throughout the year. For 2021 we will be doing Hogs for Dogs, Elimination Dinner, and 5K—all in person! We hope to add maybe one more event in fall as well.

Yearly vaccines to prevent Parvo/Distemper/etc as well as rabies are of upmost importance. Lymes vaccines, as well as flea and tick prevention is key for your dog's health. Lyme's disease is prevalent in WV due to deer ticks. Fleas can cause a host of issues, including tape worms and anemia. Make sure to have plenty of shade and cool water for your pets when out and about to protect from heatstroke. Some dogs also require sunscreen!

And as always—a collar with name and updated correct phone number. Microchips are also helpful. Did you know that many dogs go missing during Fourth of July due to fears related to noise (fireworks), campfires, and too many people? Best bet is to keep them inside the house in a safe quiet room to prevent them darting out in fear.

That animals can often have the same autoimmune issues that humans have.


We are constantly learning here at the shelter about animals and diseases or disorders.

Andre was a surrender from a family that no longer wanted him. No real information was given, but we are thankful he landed in our hands as we quickly noticed he had some irregularities in skin and gait/walk that are abnormal, especially for puppies.

At 4 months old he had to have a skin measurement taken, which led to a biopsy, and then diagnosis of EDS (Ehler Danlos Syndrome). It affects the joints, skin and blood vessels. Many dogs with EDS live a healthy happy life with regular vet care, however their lives are often shortened.

We are happy to report he is in a foster home with a young lady who also has EDS—so this puppy will know love, with knowledge of how he needs to stay protected from injury.

Any time you have a pet with irregularities, please have them vet checked, and get a second opinion if your gut is telling you something isn't right. It can be lifesaving to have the correct information.

Meet Loaf! Loaf is a 10 year old neutered male. He has been in and out of the shelter a few times. This guy needs a home that will take him on plenty of walks and let him have quiet space when he needs it. Loaf is an older guy who is on Rimadyl for pain relief. When he is off those meds, and the pain creeps up- his only way to tell you he hurts is to react via bad behaviors (nipping/biting). We have never seen these behaviors here at the shelter because we keep him on pain management meds. We see him flourish on these meds- even running and playing outside with Maizie who is much younger and very rambunctious with him

He does not do well with children, so we will say no kids in the home. He also is WAY too interested in cats, so no cats or small animals. We would love to see Loaf and his Best Friend Maizie go together—but because those both have issues that would need a super dog savvy person, we understand that will most likely not happen. They both are such wonderful dogs that will enjoy each other here for as long as they need too, and until they find the absolute best forever home. For now they enjoy their daily play yard time together.

Maizie is a 2 year old spayed female. We don't know her true past but we do know she is frightened by new people and new experiences. But she is sweet as pie once she gets to know you and she's dog friendly. Since Maizie has never had anything constant in her young life, she treasures what she does have and can be protective over her person especially children, she loves them. This is not a flaw. She has the potential to pull out of the behavior given someone will dedicate their time to her. She is house trained, and knows basic commands. Maizie absolutely deserves her forever. She struggles with seeking attention, which leads to mouthing, and with meeting new people. She has been returned a few times due to people not understanding her true needs.

If you are dog savvy, especially with reactivity, and you have the time and means to do right by Maizie - please reach out. SHE NEEDS DEDICATION.





Rocky, AKA Tater, is on his third trip back here to the HSHC. First time in 2019 - there was an incident between dogs in the home. So we say no dogs for this big guy.

The second time we thought was his happy furever after, but unfortunately there is a serious family illness that made him need to come back. Rocky is a good boy - but big boy. Even after losing weight from his first go round (we has gone from 120 to 95!! Yeah Tater!) he is just a BIG boned boy. He loves to play with toys and although hard to see, and deaf, he enjoys the yard outside. Did we mention he loves toys? He is an American Bull dog around 8-10 years old. He has normal old age complaints (bad eyes, deaf, arthritis) - nothing that can't be helped with supplements and medications. He is neutered, up to date on vaccines, and is ready for adoption. His fee is sponsored - however keep in mind a free dog doesn't mean they don't cost anything! He will need medications, etc so please be prepared to handle vet bills for this old guy.
